KEY STAGE 2 SATS

In 2008 there were 15 pupils who took the KS2 SATs. Pupils are expected to reach Level 4 in KS2 and we are very pleased that all our pupils achieved this in all 3 subjects.

School Statutory Targets

In line with Government legislation, the school has set statutory targets for Year 6 pupils in 2009. These targets indicate the percentage of pupils expected to achieve Level 4.

- ◆ For English the target is 100%.
- ◆ For Maths the target is 100%.

The following targets indicate the percentage of pupils expected to achieve the higher level 5 in 2009.

- ◆ For English the target is 35%
- ◆ For Maths the target is 35%
- ◆ The school has small cohorts of pupils and each year group represents a different ability range. These facts should be considered when interpreting statistics. We aim for each child to achieve the highest standards possible, irrespective of end of Key Stage levels.
